We have also added one addition model to the original planned line up which is the 10' Monster light. This model sits quite nicely between the 10' Mega & 10' Monster standard.

Our heaviest rail rod, CX70 Invictus has just returned from a solid work out on a long range trip on the "Intrepid".

From all reports the CX70 Invictus performed beyond expectation.

A CX70 Invictus has been left onboard the "Intrepid" for a few more long range trips & will be continually fished & tested by the crew.
